


## **Multi-Drug Instant Test**

## **Test Procedure**

IMPORTANT: Test device, client sample (urine specimen), and controls should be brought to room temperature prior to testing. Do not open pouch until ready to perform the assay.

- 1. Remove the test device from the sealed pouch.
- 2. Remove cap from test device.
- 3. Dip the sample pad of the test device into the urine sample. **Do not introduce urine beyond the plastic on test device.** Remove test device from the urine after 10 15 seconds and lay device on a flat surface.
- 4. Read result at 5 minutes after the addition of sample. Do not read result after 10 minutes. If the test is left standing for longer than 8 minutes, the intensity of the colored lines may change.

\*Note: The above results are for illustration purposes only, see the explanations below for interpretation of results.

**Negative:** The appearance of the control line at the control region (C) and the appearance of a color line at a specific test region indicate that the test is negative for that drug. The color of the test line(s) may be slightly darker or lighter than the control line.

**Positive:** Only one colored line is observed in the viewing window at the control region (C). No line is observed for a specific drug indicates a positive test result for that particular drug.

**Invalid:** No line appears in the control (C) region. The test is inconclusive even if there is a line in the test region. If the test device does not produce a line at the control region, check testing procedures, samples, and/or control materials, and repeat the test.
